These 3 were the Incorporating Officers of the **Association for the Advancement of Gestalt Therapy (AAGT)**. With the assistance of Joe Wyson, Editor of the **Gestalt Journal**, Ansel filed Not-for-Profit incorporating papers, November 24, 1992 in the State of Delaware, USA with The Company Corporation, Wilmington, Delaware is the registered agent representing AAGT.

AAGT's Association Formation Meeting in Montreal, Quebec, April 22, 23 & 25, 1993.

This meeting was held during the 15th Gestalt Journal Conference in Montreal, Quebec, Canada. During which it was announced that the **Certificate of Incorporation of the "Association for the Advancement of Gestalt Therapy"** was officially approved January 28, 1993 as a non-stock and non-profit corporation by the Secretary of State for the State of Delaware. Secretary *pro-tem*, Ansel Woldt presented the **hand-written draft of AAGT's Constitution and By-Laws**, which was contemplated, critiqued, discussed and re-drafted by gestaltists attending.

AAGT's 1st General Meeting was held on 5/11/94 in Toronto, Canada in conjunction with the Gestalt Journal Conference. What we consider to be the first "AGM" (Annual General Meeting) was on 5/12/94 in Charlie & Ann Bowman's hotel room, during which we decided to create an **Annual International Gestalt Therapy Conference**. To do so we organized to have a **Conference Planning meeting in Denver, CO**, to initiate plans for the first **AAGT Conference**. Bob and Rita Resnick volunteered to coordinate the Denver meeting.

AAGT's First Conference Planning Meeting, Denver, Colorado Airport Hotel - October 1-3, 1994 Bob and Rita Resnick sent out an announcement inviting Gestalt therapists throughout the world to a two-day meeting to lay the groundwork for planning AAGT's first conference. 18 Gestaltists attended at personal expense. Liv Estrup was contracted to serve as conference coordinator.

1st AAGT International Conference, New Orleans, LA. October 12-15, 1995. Theme: "Bringing Us Together." Conference Coordinators: Liv Estrup (salaried) & Maya Brand. New Orleans Contact: Anne Teachworth. **President Maya Brand and President-elect, Carl Hodges, co-presided at the Annual General Meeting (AGM), 10/12/95, 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM** with over 100 Gestalt therapists participating. (Historic Note: About 60 went to the pub across the street from the hotel after the meeting adjourned to toast our accomplishments and celebrate with libations and Charlie Bowman got stuck with the bill for all who didn't divvy up.)
